

Fix Scratched Headlights and Foglights

Hi all I just wanted to post a good Idea my dad and I came up with for fixing pitted or scratched headlights and foglights. My fog lights on my 99 coug with 70k on it looked like someone had sandblasted them and had almost no efect ot night. I was planing to go to the dealer and pull out the credit card and buy new ones when my dad suggested treating them just like they were the paint on the car

the things you will need 1: 1500 grit sandpaper 2: a high speed buffing wheel 3: 3m plastic polish

step one remove the foglights

step two wet sand the surface of the lights with 1500 grit sandpaper tell the pitting disapears this took a while on my lights

step three you need a high speed buffing wheel and 3m plastic polish my dad said i could use regular buffing compound I chose the plastic polish it probibly works a little beter buff the lights with a fair amount of plastic polish I put the foglights in a vice to hold them tight

step four reinstall the lights and enjoy

Notes: use a lambs wool polishing pad with the buffer
